- Residents are only eligible for one award from the College
- Applicants who receive a substantial scholarship or acknowledgement from another source/s may not be eligible to receive further support from the College
- Applicants are required to disclose if they have become ineligible to receive a Scholarship from the College
- In 2009 one third of College fees will equal to \$3,685. College fees are based on a 34 week academic year. Scholarships do not include ancillary fees.
