

Enid Russell Scholarship

Enid Russell was the first West Australian Woman to graduate in law and in 1931, practiced in the Supreme Court. This Scholarship, funded by monies bequeathed to St Catherine's from the Estate of Enid Russell, provides financial support to a resident pursuing academic achievement and excellence.

Criteria

- Undergraduate accepted at any Western Australian University and accepted at St Catherine's College
- Displays strong leadership qualities
- Displays academic potential and embodies the pursuit of excellence
- Displays a strong sense of engagement in wider community issues
- At an educational disadvantage (distance, finance, culture or added responsibility of family members)

Value: \$5,000 annually

College Residential Art or Sport Scholarship

This Scholarship provides financial support to a resident pursuing academic achievement and excellence, and who displays the potential for high sport or artistic achievement.

Criteria

- Undergraduate enrolled in a Western Australian university and accepted to St Catherine's College
- Displays academic potential and embodies the pursuit of excellence
- Displays a strong sense of engagement in wider community issues
- Displays high potential for sport or artistic achievement.

Value: \$2,000 annually
